The petition to support better funding for Outof-Hours Music and Arts (OOHMA) programmes in our communities. Out-of-hours Music and Arts (OOHMA) programmes give access to 56,000 hours of professional music and arts tuition in our communities every year.

In recent years the number of available hours that the Ministry of Education funds has not been enough to meet the demand for these programmes.

In late 2022 the OOHMA tutors won their first pay increase in nearly two decades.

This has helped schools to attract and keep highly skilled tutors. OOHMA tutors also gained access to paid time for their preparation and planning of lessons.

However, the Ministry of Education did not increase OOHMA funding to cover these necessary changes. This means that schools don't have the money they need to provide classes.

Without increased funding, some of these programmes <u>will</u> face cuts!
