While the living wage (currently \$23.65 and from September \$26.00 an hour) has formed a baseline for wages in the core public service and in public hospitals, our state and state-integrated primary and secondary schools are out of step with these developments. Being paid under the living wage means that workers lose precious time with their family, are unable to cover their basic necessities, or live with dignity.

The living wage schools campaign aims to change this reality by securing funding from the central government for schools so that they can pay their direct or contracted cleaners, caretakers, canteen staff, or grounds keepers the living wage. This ensures that schools are not burdened with the financial cost of guaranteeing the living wage, given the underfunded reality of education.
